What do the fees cover?

In addition to your club fees, all players are required to pay Lacrosse Scotland membership. Lacrosse Scotland is the governing body for lacrosse in Scotland. Among other things, this subscription covers insurance for training and matches.

Full year adult membership: £145
Full year student membership: £125

Part Season Members

This option is available, by arrangement with the treasurer, to players who will not be in Glasgow for the whole season, e.g. study abroad students, those moving to, or away from Glasgow during the season. This will cover the cost of training and matches for part of the season.
